When anyone encounters or believes they may have encountered a munition, they should consider it extremely dangerous. To protect yourself, your family, your friends and your community, it is important to follow the 3Rs of Explosives Safety should you know or suspect you have come across a military munition:

- ⇒ **Recognize:** Recognize when you may have come across a munition, and that munitions are dangerous.
- ⇒ **Retreat**: Do not approach, touch, move, or disturb a suspected munition. Carefully leave the area.
- ⇒ **Report**: Immediately report what you saw and where you saw it to local enforcement. Call 911.
